
Prof. Roderick Macababbad Tumanguil, a faculty member of our BS Respiratory Therapy Program under the College of Allied Health Sciences ranked 1st in the Licensure Examination for Respiratory Therapist. The said examination was the first licensure examination for respiratory therapists in the Philippines and was undertaken by 790 examinees of which only 326 passed. Prof. Tumanguil garnered an average of 88.75%.
