The Cagayan State University is a premiere comprehensive research university of choice among undergraduate, graduate and professionals in the country - a portal of quality and globally competitive manpower resources.





•Support in the participation of faculty and staff to international and local trainings/seminars and conferences.






•The College of Teacher Education at Andrews has purchased 12 electronic equipment for the electronic classrooms

The university has recruited additional part-time faculty members to augment its current teaching force in response to the consistently increasing enrolment in practically all campuses.








Series of program review and planning workshop for research and extension was conducted to beef up the research and extension undertakings of the university.



Initial effort has been made by the administration to transform CSU Piat as ECO-TOURISM and AGRO INDUSTRIAL CENTER.










The University was able to realize an income of **P 10,776,783.27** from the different Income Generating Projects (IGPs) in the entire university from January-June 2013.
